GOA ANTI TOBACCO FILM FESTIVAL 2017 REGULATIONS

1. SHORT TITLE

These Regulations may be called the Anti Tobacco Film Festival 2017 Regulations.

2. AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

The aim of the Anti Tobacco Film Festival 2017, organized by the Entertainment Society of Goa is to select Ad Films and Short films to spread the message of Harmful effects of Tobacco use and its ill effects and also to decrease the incidence of Oral Cancer in Goa, and also for the promotion of film art through the non-profit screening of these films and:

3. SECTIONS

The Anti Tobacco Film Festival 2017 will have the following sections:-

- (1) Ad Films
- (2) Short films

4. ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

The following conditions must be fulfilled by all entries:

4.1 The film should only be in Konkani, Marathi, Hindi or English Language for the Ad Film Category and Short Film being produced by **Goan producers/Production Houses, Goan Individuals, Students studying in Goa and educational and social institutions** only.

4.2 ALL FILMS MUST CARRY ENGLISH SUBTITLES
(except than English films).

4.3 The Ad Film should be not more than 2 minutes and Short Film should be between 5 to 10mins.

4.4 a) A maximum of One entry would be allowed in each section (as mentioned above in 3) to **Goan producers/ Production Houses, Goan Individuals, students studying in Goa and educational and social institutions**.

4.5 Disqualification:

- (a) In case of programmes originally made for television, entries sent in telecast format with commercial breaks, advertisements, channel logos/IDs etc.
- (b) Dubbed or revised versions.
- (c) Films NOT subtitled in English. (Filmmakers may please ensure that sub-titles are clear and readable. Subtitles should not merge with visuals/background. It would help jury understand the right context and help evaluate the film better. All spoken words should be sub-titled).

- (d) Entries received in sub-standard digital quality.
- (e) An applicant would be disqualified automatically for consideration of his/her entry if it is found that he /she is influencing any member of the jury.

5. PROCEDURE FOR ENTERING FILMS

5.1 The producer(s) and /or right holder (s) may apply on the prescribed entry form which are available on the following websites: www.esg.co.in and www.iffigoa.org Termed as “**Anti Tobacco Film Festival Entry Form**”.

5.2 Each entry form shall be accompanied by the material detailed below (soft copy of the same to be sent to info@iffigoa.org):

- (a) Acceptable formats for Ad films and Short films are of Digital Format.
- (b) Synopsis (precise and not exceeding fifty words) of the film, Director & Producer’s profile, Director’s note in English and details of cast and crew (Soft copy of the same to be emailed to info@iffigoa.org).

5.3 Entries must be sent along with a non-refundable fee of Rs. 500/- for both the categories of films. The fee should be remitted through a crossed Demand Draft in favour of the “The Entertainment Society of Goa”.

5.4 The last date for receipt of applications along-with supporting materials is 25th May 2017. In case that day is declared a holiday, the next working day will be treated as the last date for receipt of Entries. Applications received after the last date may be rejected without any reference to the applicant.

5.6 In case any of the requirements mentioned in this part of the Regulations are not complied with by the applicant, the entry is liable to be rejected summarily.

6. SELECTION OF FILMS FOR ANTI TOBACCO FILM FESTIVAL 2017.

6.1 The Selection Committee will comprise of a 5 Member Jury.

6.2 A person will be ineligible to serve on a Jury ONLY if his own film is an entry. In the event of his / her close relative being associated with the particular film, the Jury member shall recuse himself/herself from the preview of the film.

6.3 The decision of the juries shall be final and binding and no appeal or correspondence regarding their decision shall be entertained.

6.4 The best 2 films per category will be awarded.

6.5 The best 5 films in each Category will be screened on the day of the Awards and also in other parts of Goa in Cinema theatres, on TV channels, schools, colleges and other government programmes by the organizers.

6.6 The prizes for the best AD films & Short films in each category are as follows

1st Best Film – Rs. 100000/-

2nd Best Film – Rs. 50000/-

3rd, 4th, 5th Best Film – Rs. 25000/- each

7. ARBITRATION

Should any dispute or difference arises between the Producer and the Entertainment Society of Goa, the same shall be referred to the Secretary, Ministry of Information and Broadcasting, Government of India, whose decision in the matter shall be final and binding on both the parties. The Arbitration Clause will not apply on the decision of Juries, which will be final and binding on both the Directorate of Film Festivals and the applicant for Indian Panorama.

An Affidavit shall be furnished by the applicant on a stamp paper of the value of Rs. 50/-
